Repopulation Instructions for Grizzly Flats Community Services (GFCSD) Customers

1. DO NOT DRINK YOUR TAP WATER – Your water may be contaminated with unknown substances due to the Caldor Fire. Do not use the water for any purpose other than flushing toilets.
2. DO NOT ATTEMPT TO TREAT THE WATER - Boiling, freezing, filtering, adding chlorine or other disinfectants, or letting water stand will not make the water safe.
3. BRING YOUR OWN POTABLE WATER – Purchase water bottles or water jugs to transport water to your home. The GFCSD will continue to bring a limited amount of bottled water to the community.
4. STAY INFORMED – Conditions are changing quickly. The GFCSD will continue to provide detailed updates through the website www.grizzlyflatscsd.com and the Facebook page: Grizzly Flats Community Services District. You may also contact GFCSD staff at gfwater@sbcglobal.net or (530) 622-9626.



District staff have been working diligently to assess and repair damage to the water system for over two weeks. We meet daily with CalFire and other responding agencies. We are coordinating with the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Drinking Water to develop a water quality testing program for us to follow prior to declaring water potable. While there is no current estimated date of water service restoration, we understand that residents want to repopulate the area. We remain committed to reestablishing water service to the remaining homes as quickly as possible. We appreciate your patience during this recovery period.
